The Petersham is set on Richmond Hill looking across Petersham Meadows to the bend in the Thames – one of the UK's most famous views, painted by both Joshua Reynolds and JMW Turner. The privately-owned 60-room hotel dates back to 1865, it was created by the architect John Giles who designed The Langham hotel in Portland Place, London. Today, the hotel's restaurant, *Restaurant at The Petersham*, is headed up by chef Alex Bentley. His menu features British Classics using fresh seasonal ingredients.
