August 2010: 2010 marks the Diamond Jubilee Year of Edinburgh's celebrated Royal Military Tattoo which takes place from 6-28 August. To celebrate, The North Bridge Bar has created a special, limited edition **Royal Military Tattoo** cocktail.

Created by Head Barman Andrew Watson, the **Royal Military Tattoo** cocktail is a mix of handmade Scottish tablet muddled with lemon & lime wedges, stirred with crushed ice and topped with Drambuie and Talisker, a 10 year old malt whisky. Priced at just £7.00, the cocktail will be available until the end of August.

Established as one of the places in the capital to see and be seen, The North Bridge Bar at The Scotsman is renowned, as much for its rich, opulent interior as for its menu of Original and Modernist cocktails that reflect the classic and contemporary interior design mix of the building. The menu also features over 70 rare and exciting single malts, an extensive wine list and an all-day bar menu.

Against the world famous backdrop of Edinburgh Castle the Tattoo's landmark 60th anniversary production will feature awe-inspiring colour, talent and variety from the four corners of the globe including pipers, gymnasts, singers, dancers and an amazing motorcycle display team.
